



- Income and Expense
 - Net Income year ending March 2024 was £880.60
 - Next 12 months running costs estimated at £1,665
 - Cost of renovations needed are around £100,000
 - We need insulation, heating, new kitchen facilities, new roof for the storeroom, new windows, doors and woodwork, electrical installation and plumbing
 - · Asbestos survey
 - · External decoration
 - Groundwork to enable parking space installation
 - Planning costs



Financing Renovation

- How will we fund the renovation?
 - · CAF Fundraiser / Go Fund Me
 - Total raised to date £2,615 (Gift Aid excluded)
 - Ambition to recruit more fundraisers
 - Form a fundraising committee
 - Find Commercial partners
 - Access grant funding from charities, council and government
 - Target >£100,000
 - Better commercialize the hall
 - Card Payments accepted
 - · Raffle at every event
 - · Licenced drink sales
 - Online presence
 - More events open to people outside the village
 - Maximise income to cover costs
 - · Encourage rentals



Why Do We Need To Renovate?

- Rotten windows and doors
- No effective heating
- Poor insulation
- Kitchen needs work
- Damp and mould are a problem
- There is asbestos in the building
- Not currently sustainable for future generations
